Scholarships After Acceptance

Scholarships with University Recommendation

In the scheme of the JASSO Scholarships and some private scholarships, each Japanese University will conduct the preliminary selection and recommend their candidates to JASSO and some relevant organizations.

To be eligible for scholarships for privately-funded international students that require recommendation from the university, you must submit relevant documents including the Scholarship Application Form to the Students Affairs. A candidate for the Faculty of Agriculture is selected from the applicants and recommended to the Shinshu University Headquarters as a candidate for the Faculty of Agriculture. University candidates are selected from all faculty candidates at the headquarters and recommended for each scholarship.

Periodically confirm the information posted on what's New under Scholarships and Scholarships for Privately-financed International Students on the Shinshu University website as well as on bulletin boards at the Faculty of Agriculture.

Scholarships Open to Individual Application

1. Scholarship by exchange agreement between the country (city) of residence and Japanese <u>municipality</u>

Government of the country (city) of residence and Japanese municipalities (prefectures, cities) may have an exchange agreement which offers scholarship program for international students. Confirm with your government office in charge of education for information on availability and eligibility regarding such scholarships.

2. Scholarships Open to Individual Application

Individual application can be made for scholarships that do not require university recommendation on the application form. Notice on available scholarships will be posted on the website and bulletin boards as they arrive.
